

DATA COLLECTION: DOCUMENTS

One of the key activities of the project was the collection of the necessary data. Data collection involved the i) search for publications containing historical data from 1869 to 1970, ii) use of data obtained in the previous NAKI I project (e.g. data between 1921 and 2011), iii) use of data from selected institutions possessing specific data (e.g. data from mobile operators, data from the latest census or crime data). The collected data was then used for the elaboration of the individual outputs of the project, i) Database of Prague's population history, ii) Historical Population Atlas of Prague and iii) Specialized Maps.



DATABASE OF PRAGUE'S POPULATION HISTORY


The database includes

- i) statistical data from the census on the number of houses, dwellings and structure of the population (e.g., sex, age, place of birth, religion, marital status, language and literacy) in individual parts of the former territory of Prague, Prague suburbs and surrounding municipalities.
- ii) a summary of the individual attributes (i.e., data on the individual characteristics and publications from which the data were obtained).
- iii) a metadata file. In total, the database contains a set of five datasets for the years 1869, 1880, 1890, 1900 and 1910.

SAMPLES OF SELECTED PUBLICATIONS AND DATA

An example of data from the publication Statistická zpráva hlavního města Prahy, spojených obcí Karlína, Smíchova, Vinohrad, Vršovic a Žižkova a 32 sousedních obcí a osad Velké Prahy

This publication is the 41st in a series of annual periodical publications of the Statistical Commission of the Capital City of Prague. It is the first statistical yearbook of Greater Prague (after the merger of Prague with 37 neighbouring towns, villages and settlements).

The publication contains the following sections: Weather and Territorial Conditions of the Municipalities of Greater Prague; Building, Housing and Housing Statistics; Population Status and Currency; Health; Sickness and Workmen's Accident Insurance; Municipal Assets, Revenues and Expenditures; Taxes and Surcharges; Municipal Levies and Charges; Municipal Credit and Insurance Institutions; Transportation; Consumer and Price Statistics; Social Statistics; Education, Folk Education, Arts; and Criminal Statistics. A number of data are processed in territorial detail of urban districts or former independent municipalities and settlements.

An example of data from the publication Statistika královského hlavního města Prahy (1871)

This is an important publication in terms of the history of Prague statistics, it is the first ever publication issued by the Statistical Office of the Capital City of Prague. It contains tables and annotated summaries of statistical data on Prague based on the 1869 description. Data on the population (e.g., the number of inhabitants, sex and age, nationality, marital and household status, infant mortality, number of births and marriages, trade conditions, the growth of Prague and its surroundings), schools, livestock, wealth and economy of the municipality were collected. Topographical and climatic conditions in Prague were also described. Data were collected for different territorial units, some data only for the whole territory, others for individual quarters, parishes or even "descriptive wards".
